Barnoin River Camp is located in remote northern Quebec, 900 miles north of Montreal / 250 miles from Schefferville / 100 miles east of Kuujjuaq. Ungava Bay is less than 25 miles north of the camp. A very short flight takes you to superb fishing sites, where you'll catch the remarkable Arctic char, as well as speckled trout, sea trout, and lake trout. September is the prime time to hunt caribou and black bears.



Barnoin river camp has a more adventurous approach than Rapid Lake, but also offer some comfortable accommodations. Experience world class sport fishing and hunting in some of the most beautiful landscape of the whole Ungava region.



Barnoin River camp can accommodate 16 clients per day. The recent accommodations are provided with electricity, heat, hot shower and daily room service.
