Trip description

This expedition to the northeast extremity of North America offers you the opportunity to discover one of the least-known regions of continental Canada. In an unusual world where nature has protected all its wealth, you will explore magnificent landscapes and in turn discover the secrets behind the myths of this forgotten land.

Trip Itinerary

Day 1: Montreal / Kuujuaq / Barnoin Camp Flight ➤ Upon arrival at Barnoin Camp, the manager will welcome you with a cocktail, followed by an informational meeting concerning safety and equipment preparation for the next day's flight to the Land's End. Dinner and overnight stay at the lodge.

Day 2: Floatplane flight between Barnoin Camp and Ikkudliayuk Fjord ➤ In the early morning, a floatplane will take you on a spectacular panoramic flight to the continent land's end. Heading for the northeast extremity of North America, you will follow the Ungava coast and see the world's highest tides; magnificent reversible falls; and with a little luck, the largest land carnivore on earth—polar bears. Your pilot will land on a magnificent sandy beach at Land's End. Near the landing site, you will discover fascinating archeological sites dating back thousands of years. Overnight stay under the tent.

Days 3 to 14: Trekking at Land's End ➤ This exceptional journey invites you to discover a surprising variety of coastal landscapes and presents tremendous scope for exploration, new discoveries, and opportunities to learn more about this still little-known region. The route includes the most secret and spectacular passages through rugged mountains, carved by fjords and unexplored bays. You will cross valleys with lakes and landscapes of green tundra, and ascend peaks to appreciate the immensity of the great north. Your stay will be filled with the exploration of the unknown and by study of the ancient mysteries that still mark this pristine wilderness region. This is a region of myth and mystery. At night, watch the aurora borealis. Overnight stay in tents.

Day 15: Afternoon return flight to Barnoin Camp ➤ Dinner and overnight stay at the lodge.

Day 16: Return trip ➤ Breakfast at the lodge.

The camp at Barnoin River is situated in Arctic Quebec, 1,500 km north of Montreal and 165 km east of Kuujuaq. Ikkudliayuk Fjord is less than 170 km north of the camp.

The Labrador coast has its share of mysteries! In the early 1980s, an automated weather station was discovered near Ikkudliayuk Fjord. The crew of a German submarine U-boat installed it in October 1943. The continental region of Land's End is a strategic place, rich in archaeology, and has more than 7000 years of history.
