Trip Description

This semi-guided trip formula allows you to modify any time the program submitted according to your tastes and desire. During this tour you will discover one of the most renowned rivers of Quebec's far-north; the Tunulic. You will have the luxury to be moved by floatplane towards exceptional fishing sites and will live the experience to be alone to fish in the heart of the wild endless subarctic tundra. The targeted fish species are the brook trout, the lake trout and the landlocked arctic char.

Your Itinerary

Day 1: Montreal - Kuujuaq - Rapid Lake Flight ► Upon arrival at Rapid Lake, the manager-owner will welcome you with a cocktail, followed by the emission of fishing licenses and a presentation of your upcoming itinerary. In the afternoon fish the Tunulic River. Dinner and overnight stay at the Lodge.

Day 2: Brook Trout Fishing. ► In the morning you will have the opportunity to fish for the speckled trout in the pools upstream and downstream from the lodge. For lunch at midday, take a moment to braise some of your catch over a wood-burning fire, and savour an authentic Labrador tea. In the afternoon discover the sector of the hundred pools and fish in direct sight with the speckled trouts who fight to take your fly / bait. Overnight stay at the lodge.

Day 3 and 4: Fly-out by floatplane and fish for Lake Trout, Brook Trout and Landlocked Arctic Char. ► En-route for your fishing spot you'll be flying over a magnificent landscape of tundra with lakes and rivers as far as your eyes can see. We will put you down on a portion of the Tunulic River to pick you back at the end of the day. You will have here the opportunity to fish for lake trouts, brook trouts and landlocked arctic chars. For the evening meal, try some of your day's catch, smoked or BBQ style. Overnight stay at the Lodge.

Day 5: Fish Brook Trout and Lake Trout. ► Take advantage of this last day of fishing to fish on surface with mice patterns and small fish imitations. Make the hungry lake trouts and brook trouts jump out of the water to catch your fly. **Optional:** fly-out by float plane to one of the most prolific portions of the Tunulic River and live the authentic experience to fish and explore from a drifting pneumatic boat. Overnight stay at the lodge.

Day 6: Return trip. Breakfast at the Lodge.

In early July when the water is still freezing cold, all fish species feed near the water's surface and the lake trout are especially feeding on large dry flies and small mouse patterns that scurry across the water's surface.





It's frequent to see the brook trout taking on surface flies and lures.
