Trip Description

Your semi-guided fishing trip starts off with a full orientation from an experience arctic char fly fishing guide. You will be shown everything you need to know about where and how to catch the chars. Once we have you catching fish, you get to be in charge of your own schedule. This type of package will please the fishermen that want a complete experience in the heart of Nunavik wilderness.

Your Itinerary

Day 1: Montreal - Kuujuaq – Barnoin River Flight ➤ Upon arrival at Barnoin Camp, the manager-owner will welcome you with a cocktail, followed by the emission of fishing licenses and a presentation of your upcoming itinerary. In the afternoon fish the Barnoin River. Dinner and overnight stay at the Lodge.

Day 2: Floatplane fly-out and arctic char fishing on the Koroc. Early in the morning you will fly-out to the Koroc river. The floatplane will drop you off at the mouth of the river where you will fish the main pools and rapids. At the end of the day, the floatplane will pick you back to return to Barnoin. For the evening meal, try some of your day's catch, smoked or BBQ style. Overnight stay at the lodge.

Day 3 and 4: Fly-out by floatplane and fish the Baudoncourt. ➤ In flight for the Baudoncourt river you'll have the opportunity to observe the highest tide of the world, as well as the reversible waterfalls and occasionally icebergs and even polar bears. We'll drop you off at the mouth of the Baudoncourt where you will fish for anadromous arctic chars. Baudoncourt is famous for his big arctic chars that average 10 lbs. For lunch at midday, take a moment to braise some of your catch over a wood-burning fire. Overnight stay at the Lodge.

Day 5: Fish the Koroc / Baudoncourt / Upper Baudoncourt. ➤ You have a very wide choice! If you wish, you can return fishing on the rivers that you have already experienced, or you can keep on discovering new pools and rapids and try to catch big red chars. Overnight stay at the lodge.

Day 6: Return trip. Breakfast at the Lodge.

The Barnoin River Camp is situated in Arctic Quebec 1,500 km north of Montreal and 165 km east of Kuujuaq. Ungava Bay is located less than 40 km north of the camp. In just a few minutes flight time from the outfitter, you'll be able to experience exceptional Arctic char fishing sites. You may also fish for brook trout, sea trout and lake char. Accommodations are comfortable.



You'll live an exceptional moment with nature. You'll hear far off the floatplane propeller roaring sound... It's leaving you. You will experience fishing on wild rivers in the heart of lost landscapes, distant where the nature is intact.



Arctic char fishing is very similar to salmon and requires a fast reaction from the fisherman. These anadromous chars are big fighters and it's frequent to see them strip off 100 feet of line in a fraction of a second.
